Roxio Secure Burn

User Guide for Mac



Roxio[®] Secure Burn[™] is an application that lets you encrypt data and burn it to a disc or copy it to a USB storage device.

The workspace



The workspace consists of three key areas:

- 1 **Toolbar area** Lets you access navigation, add and remove files and folders, and specify a disc or drive name
- 2 File area Drag and drop the files that you want to encrypt and burn to disc or copy to a USB storage device. You can navigate through the files, view basic file information, and perform basic file management tasks (create folders, rename or delete files and folders).
- 3 Drive area Lets you select a disc or USB storage device, choose settings, and initiate the encryption and burning or copying action. It also displays information such as the number of files and folders added to the File area and the free and used space for your project.

Tools and controls

The following tools and controls are available in the workspace:

- Navigation Let you navigate through the folders in the File area
- Add Lets you add files or folders by navigating the Finder.



Remove — Lets you remove files or folders



Add New Folder — Lets you create a folder



Start — Starts the burn to disc or copy to USB action



Settings — Lets you set preferences related to data verification level (**Off** or **Basic**) and lets you enable a close disc option (automatically closes the disc when you burn to prevent future revisions to the disc.



Eject — Lets you eject a disc from the selected drive

Encrypting, burning, and copying

Follow the steps below to encrypt and burn or copy your files to a disc or USB storage device. After you encrypt the files, you can access them by using the RoxioBurnReader.

To encrypt and burn (disc) or copy (USB) your files

- 1 In Roxio Secure Burn, drag-and-drop the files that you want to burn or copy to the File area.
- 2 Do one of the following:
 - Insert a writable disc into an internal or external CD/DVD drive for your computer
 - Plug a USB storage device into your computer

The disc or USB device should appear in drop-list in the Drive area.

- 3 From the device drop-list in the Drive area, select a disc drive or USB device.
- 4 In the upper-right corner, type a name in the **Disc Volume Name**.
- 5 Click the Start button 🚱
- 6 In the **Password** box, type a password, and retype it in the **Verify** box.

Your password must follow the security rules listed in the window before you can continue.

If you want to set the password as your default, mark the **Set as default** check box.



Warning: You must enter the password to access the encrypted files on the disc or USB storage device. If you forget the password, there is <u>no way to retrieve the password or access the files</u>.

Opening files encrypted with Roxio Secure Burn

You can open files encrypted with Roxio Secure Burn by using RoxioBurnReader. You can then add more files to the encrypted folder (Roxio Secure Folder), or remove files from the folder.

To open files encrypted with Roxio Secure Burn

- 1 On the disc or the USB storage device that contains the encrypted files, open the **Roxio Secure Folder**.
- 2 Open the **RoxioBurnReader** application.
- 3 Type your password when prompted.

The files open in **RoxioBurnReader**. To copy the files to an unencrypted location, click the **Copy to** button, and choose a location.
